## 2018 Louise Eleanor Ross Kleinhenz Scholarship for mature woman or man

Application deadline: April 6, 2018

WPCI (Woman's Press Club of Indiana) will present a \$500 scholarship to a mature Indiana woman or man (30 years or older) desiring to upgrade her/his skills in order to re-enter the journalism market OR to upgrade a position in that field. The scholarship is known as the Louise Eleanor Ross Kleinhenz Scholarship in memory of Louise Eleanor Ross Kleinhenz, a 45-year-member of WPCI who served the organization as president, historian and *Bulletin* editor before her death in 1977.

## Each application packet shall include ALL of the following:

- The completed application form (attached.)
- A narrative essay of 150-300 words, written by the applicant, telling the scholarship/award committee why she/he desires to improve journalism skills and how she/he would accomplish that. This autobiographical essay is to be titled and is to follow all the conventions of a well-written piece of prose.
- If the applicant has samples of her/his journalistic work, she/he is to include a few non-returnable copies.

The Kleinhenz scholarship winner will be invited to attend the June 2 WPCI awards luncheon as a guest of the Woman's Press Club of Indiana, when the award will be presented. The winner is responsible for travel expenses. Luncheon details will be provided upon scholarship notification.

The scholarship winner has one year from the date of receiving the scholarship to enroll at a public or private college or university or other related venue to take a course or workshop for credit or non-credit. The course or workshop must improve the winner's skills in one of the following categories:

- newspaper editorial, advertising or promotion;
- magazine writing, editing, photography, graphics/layout or advertising;
- public relations or advertising copywriting or graphics for brochures, news releases, radio/TV public service announcements, planning campaigns or doing promotions;
- commercial or public radio or television news, advertising or promotion;
- journalism-related website and/or social media, or
- journalism education.

The Woman's Press Club of Indiana will send the scholarship recipient a check of \$500 when the winner submits evidence to the WPCI treasurer that she/he has enrolled in a course/workshop. This may be a photocopy of a receipt or class schedule certified by the instructor or department head. The receipt should specify the title and date of the course/workshop. The winner will have one year from the date of receiving the scholarship to enroll in a course to fulfill the requirements of this scholarship.
