2019 WPCI Hortense Myers Scholarship for college juniors

URGENT: Deadline to apply has been extended to March 30, 2019

WPCI (Woman's Press Club of Indiana) will present a \$1,000 scholarship to a college junior, male or female, majoring in journalism. The recipient must commit to continuing his/her education in journalism, intending to earn a degree. The scholarship is known as the Hortense Myers Scholarship in memory of Hortense Myers, a former UPI Statehouse reporter who is remembered as a fair but relentless reporter who sought the truth in every story she pursued.

Each application packet shall include <u>ALL</u> of the following:

- The completed application form (attached).
- An official transcript through the fall semester of the junior year.
- At least one but not more than three letters of recommendation from school and/or work adults (teachers, counselors, administrators, club sponsors, bosses, etc.). These adults may have known/worked with the applicant while the applicant was still in high school.
- A narrative essay of 150-300 words, written by the applicant, telling the scholarship/ award committee about an experience he/she has had that helped influence his/her decision to major in journalism. The autobiographical essay is to be titled and is to follow all the conventions of a well-written piece of prose.

The completed application packet is to be mailed, with a postmark on or before March 30, 2019, <u>OR</u> emailed by March 30, 2019, to:
