2021 Julie and Gene Slaymaker Public Service to Journalism Award

Deadline: APRIL 12, 2021

Woman's Press Club of Indiana will present a \$500 award to a qualified Indiana journalist (professional journalist or college student, male or female) who has provided public service to journalism in the past year, above and beyond that person's job description. The applicant must provide documentation from the recipient of the public service.

The award is known as the Julie and Gene Slaymaker award in memory of Gene Slaymaker, a WPCI member who died in 2012. It was established by his wife, Julie, in honor of their 30 years of service as statewide contest directors of the Indiana Professional Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists. Both Slaymakers served as president of IndyPro SPJ. They also were elected to offices in WPCI. Julie was president three times and Gene was treasurer when he died.

Each application packet shall include ALL of the following:

- The completed application form (attached).
- A narrative essay of 150-300 words, written by the applicant, telling the scholarship/award committee how he/she has given his/her time and talent to service in journalism in the past year, above and beyond the applicant's job description. The autobiographical essay is to be titled and is to follow all the conventions of a well-written piece of prose.
- A letter affirming the applicant's service to journalism, written by the recipient of that service (individual or organization, for example).

The complete application packet is to be mailed, with a postmark on or before APRIL 12, 2021, OR emailed by APRIL 12, 2021, to:
